Adults who will be spending part of the week at camp, please see Mr. Matthews to discuss exactly when you plan to be there. Any other questions? See Mr. Matthews.



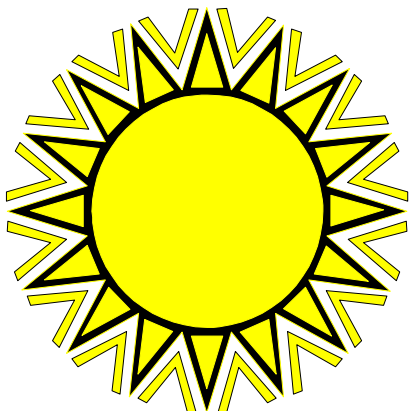
## Youth Protection Talk
